Hours of Operation:

Commercial Building/Outdoor Vendors	Food Vendors
Wednesday, July 28 from 12 PM-9PM	Wednesday, July 28 from 12 PM-11 PM
Thursday, July 29 from 10 AM-9 PM	Thursday, July 29 from 10 AM-11 PM
Friday, July 30 from 10 AM- 9 PM	Friday, July 30 from 10 AM –Midnight
Saturday, July 31 from 10 AM- 9PM	Saturday, July 31 from 10 AM- Midnight
Sunday, August 1 from 11 AM- 6 PM	Sunday, August 1 from 11 AM-6 PM

- For commercial buildings, all booths must be staffed during these times, otherwise your business/organization risks losing your deposit
- Food vendors, these are the minimum hours of operation, you are encouraged to open earlier and remain open later

Set Up & Tear Down:

- Set up will take place on Tuesday, July 27 from 9 AM- 9PM for all vendors
- All vehicles and deliveries must be made before the fair opens each day and be off of the fairgrounds
- Vendors can officially take down their booths on Sunday, August 1 at 6 PM

Electricity:

- Electricity is available in all commercial buildings, please bring appropriate plug-ins
- Outdoor and Food vendors must undergo an electrical inspection prior to opening for business

Ice Availability:

- Ice is available for purchase during the fair. Please call the **Fair Office at 952-492-2436** to request a bag
- Ice comes in 20 pound bags and cost \$8 a bag. Payment can take place in the following options:

- Pay in cash when the ice is delivered to your booth
- Pay via credit card at the Fair Office
- Keep a running tab and pay at the end of the fair on Sunday either via cash or credit card

Oil and Grease Disposal:

- Grease and used frying oil **cannot** be poured into trash barrels, dumpsters, or drains
- All used frying oil and grease is to be put in sealed containers and set **NEXT** to dumpsters by 6 AM for morning disposal
- Please label the containers “Used Frying Oil or Grease—Handle Carefully”

Smoking:

- There is no smoking allowed at any time in the commercial buildings

Table & Chair Rental:

- The Scott County Fair does not provide any table or chairs and are not available for rent
