Exhibitors must have the exact number of stalks or stems of blooms called for in each exhibit, in a clean, suitable container (**no fruit jars**), otherwise the exhibit will be disqualified. In this class the flower, stem, and foliage are judged. Foliage can be used but not below the water line. A bud showing color is counted as a bloom. Bloom and uniformity for the variety are the points the judge considers. All plants and flowers must be grown by the exhibitor. Exhibitors must furnish their own container. A bloom or blossom means an individual flower, one on a stem. A cluster means several blooms growing close together on the main stem. A spike means a flower structure with a stemless flower on a common lengthened stalk, as gladioli or snapdragon. A stalk is a stem with one or more blooms or buds. You may replace flowers during the fair. **Vases MUST BE weighted with clear or colored marbles to avoid tipping and should fit the size of the bloom.**

*heavily scented, *large blooms, *blooms have different colors on rims, *summer/fall bloomers, *2-8 feet tall, *leaf color is dull green
