



Endurance Race/ Tough Truck Race- specifics

1. Fuel: Pump gasoline or diesel only.
2. Airbags must be disabled or removed.
3. Seat belts (both lap belts and shoulder strap) are required and must be worn or a 5 point harness is preferred.
4. All vehicles must have a working brake system in good working condition.
5. Roll bars or cage are mandatory in all competition vehicles.
6. Drivers must wear a DOT approved full-face helmet. Helmet strap must be fastened. Also must have a neck brace. NO EXCEPTIONS. Must wear long sleeves and pants.
7. Vehicles must have a firewall and floor in the original location. Holes larger than 3" diameter must be covered. Only holes allowed are those for brakes, clutch, transmission controls and wiring.
8. If approved gas tanks, battery, and/or fuel lines are relocated, they must be securely fastened.
9. No tire rule.
10. No loose objects in the cab or any other place in the vehicle.
11. The engine must be in its original location as intended by the manufacturer.
12. Body, hood, bed, fenders, and wheelbase must meet OEM specifications.
13. Headers and open exhaust permitted. Exhaust must exit under the vehicle or vertically from the motor.
14. Aftermarket lift kits will be allowed. (Max lift of 4 inches) Length of suspension travel cannot be increased except to accommodate lift kit. Rear shocks must be mounted at original locations. All suspension components must be in good working condition. Racing suspension components will not be allowed.
15. Officials can shut down competition at any time if a vehicle is unsafe for the driver or the track crew.
16. The contest will be governed by track officials and the Competition Director. All decisions are final!

*The Promoter or Competition Director reserves the right to change any safety rules if they feel it is necessary.
