Thank you for volunteering at the Scott County Fair! The fair would not be the same without you. Please take a few moments to read through this volunteer handbook before your volunteer shift at the fair.

The Scott County Fair makes it a priority to put fair-goers first. We ask that all of our volunteers, employees, board members, and vendors follow our policy of treating those at the fair with utmost respect.

We are now requiring all of our volunteers to fill out a volunteer application and turn it into the Fair Office prior to the beginning of their volunteer shift!

Volunteer Information

Welcome Booth

Welcome Tent volunteers can check in directly at the tent, which is located at the entrance that connects the parking lot to the fairgrounds. The purpose of the Welcome Tent is to greet fair-goers as they enter the fairgrounds, hand out daily schedules, answer general questions about the fair, ask the fair-goers to fill out a survey after their time at the fair and drop it off at the booth on their way out, and encourage fairgoers to enter drawings (ride tickets, t-shirts, etc.) that will be announced throughout the day. If you are volunteering in the Welcome Tent, you will have a radio with you which you can use to ask the office questions or for more supplies. Thank you for helping in the Welcome Tent, it is an important part of the fair!

People Movers

People Mover drivers **MUST** check in at the **Fair Office** at the beginning of their shift. When checking in, drivers will be asked to show a Driver's License with proof that they are at least 18 years old. People Mover drivers are not allowed to pass their keys on to another volunteer after their shift, **they must turn the keys back into the Fair Office**. The purpose of People Movers is to make it easier for fair-goers to get around the grounds, especially those who cannot due to physical disabilities. Although drivers should not deny rides to any fairgoers, they should make it a priority to drive those less physically able. People Mover drivers must stay off the main road of the fairgrounds which has all of the food vendors lined up on either side unless absolutely necessary. This will ensure the safety of drivers and of fair-goers.

Miracle of Birth Center

Miracle of Birth volunteers can check in directly at the Miracle of Birth Center located in the Cattle Barn. The purpose of the Miracle of Birth Center is to educate and entertain fair-goers by focusing on animal agriculture. Volunteers will provide information to fair-goers, answer their questions, and assist in taking care of the animals present.

Creative Arts Building

Creative Arts Building volunteers can check in directly at the Creative Arts Building (Building 8). Volunteer duties include answering fair-goer questions and maintaining exhibit displays.
