## General Pulling Rules for Tractor, Semi, and Pickup Pull

### General Rules for All Classes

- No alcoholic consumption before pull.
- Pull at your own risk.
- Promoter and its agents are not responsible for any breakage.
- Judges Decisions are FINAL.
- All drivers must attend Drivers Meeting before Pull.
- Each pulling vehicle can ONLY pull in one weight class.
- Be prepared to pull when your class is called, not responsible for missed pulling opportunity.
- First puller of each class may be used as test puller to set "sled". Puller may either take or decline it, before being "unhooked". If declined, pull will be measured regardless of distance. The re-pull will be in last position.
- Tractor may be 200 lbs over with Driver. (Scale will be onsite)
- No entry fee. \$10 per person admission fee.
- Trucks hauling tractors do NOT have to pay parking fee. **All other vehicles pay \$20 to park in the pits. \$10 parking in main lot.**
- No pre entry. Enter at announcer's stand on day of pull. Entry will be by lottery system.
- Must be 16 years of age to enter.
- Pit Gate opens at 4:00 pm
- Everyone pulls that comes.

### Pick-up Pulling Rules

- Hitches no less than 36% of pick-up wheelbase, from point of hitch to center of rear axle.
- Hitch shall not exceed 26" in height.
- Open Headers are allowed in all classes.
- Maximum tire size 33 x 12.5x 16.5 for all classes.

### Improved Farm & Hot Farm Rules

- All Hot Farm tractors will be required to have air shut off that can be activated by the sled operator!
- 11,000 lbs. hot farm 466 C.I. limit, 2.8 x3 inch intake limit smooth cover turbo RPM
- 16,500 lbs. class max size of a 3 inch intake limit turbo.
- 11,000 lb. improved—stock RPMS, 466 C.I. limit, 3 LM or F300 FXE 2.45 box turbo

### Tractor Rules

- Stock block or factory replacement, must bolt to clutch housing without modification
- Only one fuel allowed, no pressurized LP booster, or nitrous oxide allowed
- Any tire size is allowed, duals allowed in 16,000 lb class
- Tractor must have hitch for skid hook min 3 inch diameter, or suitable clevis
- Tractor hitch 18" from center of rear axle and 20" height

#### 4,500, 6500 & 9500 lb Hobby Class Only Rules

- No tires bigger than 18-4-38
- No cut tires. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Torque amplifiers can be used.
- Tractor hitch 18" from center of rear axle and 20" height
- 10,000 open tractor, anything goes, must have all safety equipment

### Road Semi Rules

- Current DOT
- Licensed: Must be driven to pull to pull
- Will be using 5<sup>th</sup> wheel plate hooks



- Must drive to pull

### **Modified Mechanical Semi Rules**

- 1099 cubic inches or less
- Must have DOT approved tires
- Factory fuel pump
- Working suspension
- Recommended (but not enforced) air shut off
- Transmission blanket recommended (but not enforced)
- 20,000 lb. weight limit
- Pull from 5<sup>th</sup> wheel
- 20 inch hitch height
- Must use hitches provided by Scott County Fair

### **Open Class Semis Rules**

- Must have wheelie bars
- Breakaway switch and dead man throttle mandatory
- Scatter blanket required around clutch and flywheel
- Exhaust pipe must be cross bolted
- Helmet mandatory
- Fire suit and shoes encouraged

### **Open/ Super Farm Class**

Weight class 9,500

Class Rules: No speed or rpm limit.

- Diesel fuel only
- Single turbo-any size
- 24.5 x 32 maximum tire size, No duals, No curved exhaust pipes
- Cut tires allowed
- Aluminum parts allowed

#### **Require Safety equipment:**

- Steel flywheel, Blanket, Side Shields
- Kill switch—a minimum of a single controlled air shut off, that will disconnect at the rear of tractor where the sled hooks up
- Cage with 5 point harness and helmet
- Fire extinguisher mounted in reach of driver
- Dead man throttle, Electric or no cooling fan
- Pulling hitch, Wheelie bars, Tie bars, Weld on hubs
- Any type of safety equipment is recommended.

### **Open Class**

Weight class 9,500

#### **Class Rules**

- All general pull rules apply.
- No speed or rpm limit.
- No engine restrictions.
- Any combination of engines, transmissions and final drives.
- Make Weight & Pull

### **Mandatory Safety Equipment in (ALL) Open Classes:**

- Steel flywheel
- Air shut off—needs to disconnect at the rear of vehicle and hook to sled
- Side shields (recommended to follow the NTPA guideline)
- Rops with seatbelt, helmet--Drivers must wear long pants (no shorts).
- Wheelie bars, Fenders & Fire extinguisher, Wide Front
- Electric or no cooling fan
- Floor board must be strong enough to support the driver.
- No curved exhaust pipes.
- Any type of safety equipment is recommended.
